

## Harney County 2018 CBCs

P-Ranch CBC on Malheur National Wildlife Refuge near Frenchglen will be on Friday Dec 21, 7am meeting at P-Ranch field house. Lodging may be available at P-Ranch the night before the count and at the compiler's home in Burns the night after the count.

The Burns-Hines count will be on Saturday December 22.

We will meet at McDonald's in Hines at 7am.

Lodging available at compiler's home before and after the count. Friendly well behaved dogs are welcome.

There are options for hiking and or driving on both counts. It usually is cold (teens or twenties early morning , warming up to a balmy 35 degrees) and often snowy. Both counts average about 55 species of birds depending on the amount of frozen water. But we have reached 65-70 species. And the Burns count holds the world record for California quail, with over 10,000 just in the city limits.

There is a traditional post-count meeting tallying Bird numbers, over a main course dinner and award ceremony for numerous categories immediately after the Burns-Hines count on Saturday, Dec 22 for CBC participants.
