#### SUBSPECIES

In addition to the full species listed above, the OBRC solicits documentation for the occurrence of following select subspecies/subspecies groups in Oregon. These represent taxa that may be elevated to species level sometime in the future.

"Pale-bellied" Brant  
(*Branta bernicla hrota*)

"Bewick's" Tundra Swan  
(*Cygnus columbianus bewickii*)

"Eurasian" Whimbrel  
(*Numenius phaeopus*  
*phaeopus/variegatus* group)

"Vega" Herring Gull  
(*Larus argentatus vegae*)

Lesser Black-backed Gull - any subspecies other than *graellsii*.

"Timberline" Sparrow  
(*Spizella breweri taverneri*)
