Replace the sentence with Gabrielson and Jewett (1940) mention a colony with 200 nests near Portland, citing Finley (1906), but this was an error. A careful read of Finley (1906) reveals that the colony of 200 near Portland consisted exclusively of Great Blue Herons; a colony near San Francisco, abundantly described in the article, contained many Black-crowned Night-Herons. Nevertheless, during the spring of 1951, H. Nehls (p.c.) found four pairs of night-herons nesting in the Ross I. Great Blue Heron colony in Portland.
