IRONS AND I NOTICED A LARGE DARK SHEARWATER FLYING DIRECTLY AT THE BOAT. ITS WING BEATS WERE RATHER SLOW, APPROXIMATING THOSE OF A PINK-FOOTED SHEARWATER. THE SIZE WAS ALSO SIMILAR TO THAT SPECIES. AS IT APPROACHED ONLY THE UPPERPARTS WERE VISIBLE. WHEN IT WAS WITHIN 40 YARDS OF THE BOAT IT FLEW PARALELL TO IT AND BANKED SHOWING ITS ENTIRELY DARK UNDERPARTS. THE UNDERWINGS WERE ALSO DARK. AT THIS POINT THE PALE BILL WAS CLEARLY VISIBLE.

I AM FAMILIAR WITH THIS SPECIES AND CONFIDENT WITH THE IDENTIFICATION.
