A Northern Waterthrush - On May 10, 1977 I found a Northern Waterthrush along the willow-lined spring in Fields. The bird was very tame. Every field mark you could hope for was obvious including the sharp call note, the habitat, the walking and bobbing of the bird, the horizontal posture, the off-white eye stripe, the streaked throat and belly, and the unmarked brown back and wings. It was present for at least three days. I am familiar with this bird from Mexico and Andrew Magee who is from Massachusetts is familiar with this species and agreed completely with the identification.

I hope these sightings are of some use to you. If you wish any further details I will be happy to supply them.
