An Autumn Record of the Ovenbird (Seiurus aurocapillus) from Malhuer National Wildlife Refuge

1978 - 33

I was birding alone at the headquarters of Malhuer National Wildlife Refuge on October 1. 1977. It was near freezing and sunny.

I was walking along a short vine covered wall when an adult Ovenbird flew from the ground and onto the wall about 15 feet in front of me. I observed the following field marks during the five or more seconds that it remained in sight. It was a small bird, smaller than the nearby White-crowned Sparrows. The back was plain greenish-brown. The throat was white. The bill was thin and pointed. The white breast was well marked with black spots. These spots were not perfectly round. The crown was orange. A white eyering was conspicuous on the otherwise much darker face.

I am familiar with this species from the east and central parts of the country. Although I cannot support the sighting with photographs, I am certain of the identification and and therefore submit this record for consideration.
