Bright yellow-orange throat, black face, black stripes on side, white neck spot, gray back, white wing-bars., it has no yellow spot next to the long white supercilium. I believe it is a Adult male. The female has some Buffy coloring in the black and white sides. This bird has none.

**Date(s)**

First seen 3:00 pm on Thursday, September 10, 2020. It has been seen everyday since. (5 days) and continues to be around all day long.

**Location**

383 West D. Street. Springfield, Oregon 97477. Seen all around backyard and at Island Park, Springfield and near the Willamette River. Has mostly been seen around a suet feeder and feeder with Black Oil Sunflowers. It spends time in a Juniper tree, a Japanese Snow Drop tree, and a Lilac tree. Occasionally flies to Cottonwood trees near the river. Has been on the railing of our deck several times.

**Details**

First spotted by my wife, Mary McKrola. Until I got a photo not sure what it was, other than we knew it was a warbler. Reported to e-bird. Very soon other birders in area were looking. Not seen again that first day. Since over 50 birders have been able to spot the warbler. Many excellent photos showing its markings.

**Similar Species**

Blackburnian Warbler- It does not have black and white head, is much more orange. All other warblers I look at are not similar to yellow-throated warbler.

I believe all the birders who have come to see the bird have gotten views. Out in the open at least 20 times a day.
